Duracoat Royale Soft Satin Emulsion is a superior quality copolymer resin based emulsion paint formulated to give a soft satin finish to interior surfaces. It is extremely durable, fully washable and stain resistant paint suitable for high traffic areas where a soft satin finish is desired. It is also ideal for living room, children's room, ceiling, columns, partitions, kitchen and bathrooms.

Features/Benefits:

- The advanced stain resistant formulation ensures that stubborn stains do not penetrate the coating, keeping the soft satin finish beautiful for years.
- Easily washable.
- Excellent adhesion.

- Easy application – good flow and levelling to mask brush marks.
- High spreading rate.
- Good abrasion resistance.
- Quick drying – recoatable in 3 hours depending on the temperature and humidity in the painted area.

Application Methods:

For detailed information, please refer to the instructions on the container.

- Can be applied by brush, roller or airless spray.
- Stir well before use.

Thinning :

Use clean water to thin to brushable viscosity. **DO NOT** overthin as this can impair the final finish and the sheen level.

Spreading Rate:

Spreading rate varies according to the surface porosity and texture. Approximate spreading rates on different surfaces are given below.

Surfaces	Approx. spreading rate in sq.m/litre
Newly plastered wall	13 – 14
Previously painted wall in good condition	14 – 18
Cement rendered wood float plaster – New	11 – 13
Cement rendered wood float plaster – Previously painted	13 – 15
Concrete blocks - New, unprepared	6 – 8
Concrete blocks - Previously painted	7 – 9
Textured surfaces – New, unprepared	3 – 5
Textured surfaces – Previously painted	4 – 6

Surface Preparation:

All surfaces should be clean, dry and free from oil, grease and other impurities. Cracks and defects should be filled with appropriate crack filler.

New Surfaces: Ensure the surface is dry. Apply one coat of Duracoat Royale All Purpose undercoat followed by 2 coats of Duracoat Royale Soft Satin Emulsion.

Previously Painted Surfaces: Remove all loose, chalky, flaking materials. Powdery materials should be removed with a wire brush. Treat all surfaces with Pliolite surface conditioner. Treat surface for mould or algae if present with Duracoat Fungicidal wash. Allow to dry. Then apply a minimum of 2 coats of Duracoat Royale Soft Satin Emulsion.

Application:

Can be applied by brush, roller or airless spray. **DO NOT** overthin.

Drying:

Touch-dry in 45 minutes, overcoatable within 4-5 hours under normal drying conditions.

Shade Range :

Available from BS 4800, Duracoat Classic and Colour Plus fandeck. Special shades can be provided on request.

Pack Sizes :

Available in 1 litre, 4 litres, and 20 litres.

Good working practices :

- Read instructions carefully before painting.
- Ensure good ventilation during paint application.
- When using spray gun as an application tool, wear suitable clothing and protective equipment.
- Wash hands with water and soap.
- Keep unused paint cans tightly closed and away from children and pets.

Hints and Tips (for best results)

- Always read instructions.
- Always use a good quality brush.
- Try to paint in one motion.
- Take a small quantity of paint, thin to brushable viscosity and apply on a small area on the prepared surface to confirm shade and finish. This will avoid redoing the whole work if the shade is not suitable to your taste.

Wise Precautions:

- Ensure good ventilation during application and drying.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- After contact with skin wash immediately with plenty of soap and water. In case of contact with eye, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
- Keep out of reach of children.
