### SURFACE PREPARATION

Ensure that the surface is clean, dry and free from dust and grease before application. Apply liberally to the wall or floor where the tile has to be fixed and allow 2 minutes to dry before fixing the tile. Place tiles in position and press firmly. Apply gentle pressure and allow overnight drying.

### PAINT APPLICATION PROCESS

**Product:** Duracoat Parquet Tile Glue

**Application:** Spatula

**Thinning:** N/A

**Drying Time:** 4 hours

### PRECAUTIONS

- Ensure good ventilation during application and drying.
- Store the product at ambient conditions in well ventilated locations and away from sources of ignition and fire.
